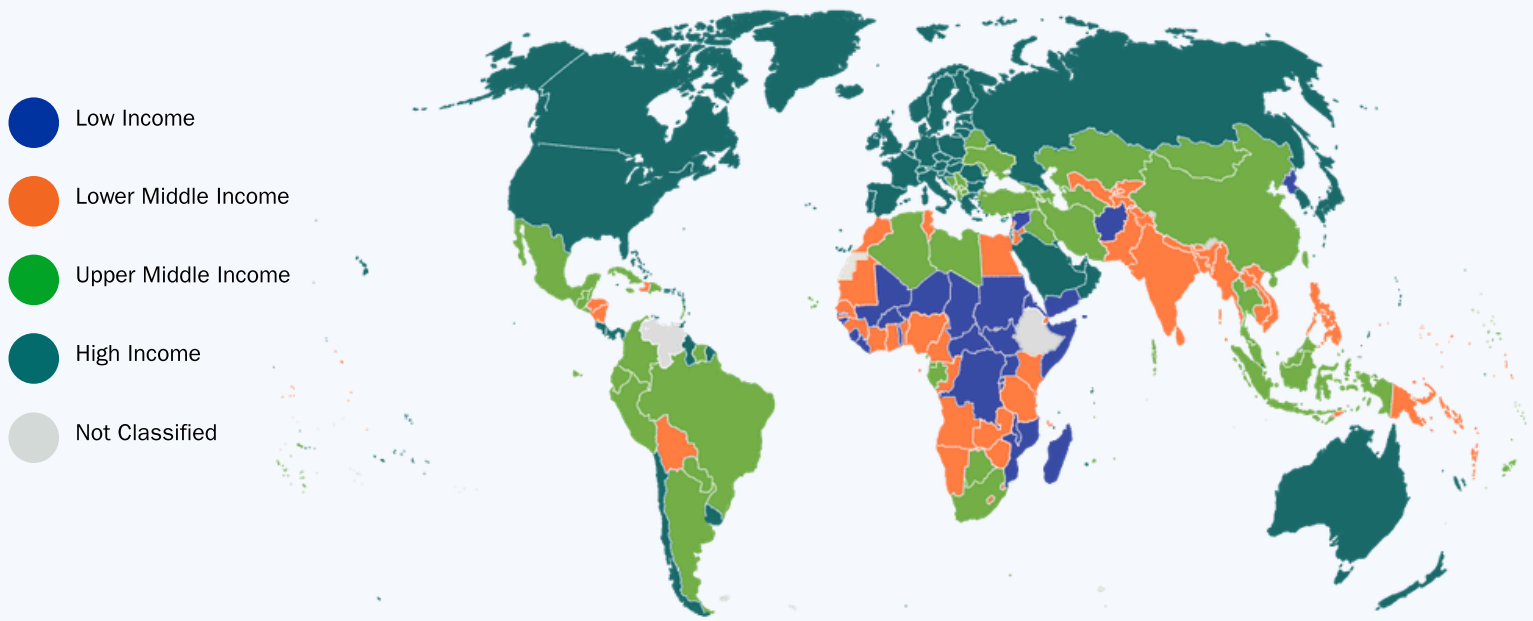


Global Pricing by World Bank Classification

The POCUS Certification Academy's goal is to make certification more accessible to healthcare professionals worldwide. We are pleased to offer reduced fees for eligible countries, in alignment with the [World Bank's](#) national income classifications.

The World Bank's national income tiers are updated every year on **July 1st** using each country's Gross National Income (GNI) per capita from the previous calendar year. Countries are classified into four tiers: low, lower-middle, upper-middle, and high income.



How to Determine Your Tier and Apply:

- Refer to the map and key above to identify your country of residence and its classification (*See full list of regions/countries/territories [here](#)*)
- Match your classification to the corresponding tier
- Follow the application instructions below to access the discounted price

Tier/ Discount Code	Classification	Discount
Tier1	Low Income	75% off
Tier2	Lower Middle Income	50% off
Tier3	Upper Middle Income	25% off

How to apply the discount code:

- Log into the [MYPOCUS Portal](#) with your POCUS number and password. If you don't have a POCUS number, create one [here](#).
- Click the green **Apply for an Examination** button to access the Learning Management System.
- Select your desired POCUS Certification Academy Certification(s), click next, and complete the attestation. (Note: POCUS Fundamentals is a prerequisite for all clinical and specialty certifications.)
- Enter your applicable discount code as displayed in the above chart. Click 'Apply', then select 'Continue.'
- Complete your application and payment to begin your certification components immediately. Click the certification name in your **Certificate Plan** to start.
