


## **Ultrasound Guided Venous Access Transverse Approach**

- A Valsalva maneuver will further augment an IJ's vein's diameter
- Use compression to differentiate the collapsible vein from the artery.
- If a transducer remains in a static position, it will not be reliable for needle advancement.
